1. HOW OUR PASTORAL INTERNS PROGRAM WORKS?

The Pastoral Interns Program (PIP) offers both Diploma and Bachelor of Ministry courses. The course is a combination of lectures, assignments and practical work. To gain credits, the students must complete the following: -

1. Attend lectures, sit and pass an examination for that module.
2. Complete reading assignments and elective texts.
3. Complete practicum supervised by a mentor

When a student accumulates sufficient credits by completing these modules, he will be awarded the Diploma/Degree of ministry. A student will take approximately 3 years for the Diploma and 4 ½ years for the Bachelor of Ministry.
