TERM 1

This course provides an in-depth study of key doctrines in Systematic Theology, focusing on Theology Proper (the Doctrine of God), Christology (the Doctrine of Christ), Pneumatology (the Doctrine of the Holy Spirit), and the Doctrine of the Trinity. Students will explore the nature, attributes, and works of God, the person and the work of Jesus Christ, the role of the Holy Spirit in creation and redemption, and the biblical foundation of the Triune Godhead. Key theological perspectives, and contemporary discussions will be examined, emphasizing biblical exegesis, theological reflection, and practical application. The course will equip students with a deeper understanding of Christian doctrine.

Rev. Wah Lok served as Principal of Tung Ling Seminary from 1999-2019. He is a pioneer member of Full Gospel Tabernacle (FGT) birthed in 1981 and pastors a branch, FGT Sri Damansara since 1992. Wah Lok is a gifted songwriter with more than 100 songs to his credit. He has released 3 albums, Every Time I Pray (2001), Shining Stars (2002) and Messiah King (2007). He is also Vice President of Malaysian Gospel Music (MGM). In 2001, he founded a worship website www.tabernaclemusic.net to feature Malaysian Gospel Music. His regular teaching topics include Music and Worship, How We got the Bible and the Book of Amos. He holds Masters Degrees in both Engineering and Theology.
